Nitroglycerine 0.4 mg SL PRN. One every 5 minutes x 3 for chest pain/angina if systolic blood pressure greater than 100.	
Start Nitroglycerine drip if chest pain not resolved. Titrate drip to systolic blood pressure 110-120 or chest pain status.	
Acetaminophen 650 mg PO every 3 hours PRN headache.	
Temazepam 15-30 mg at bedtime PRN sleep.	
Non-enteric coated aspirin _____ mg. One tab in ER and then one daily after breakfast.	
Clopidogrel (Plavix) 75 mg PO daily	
Beta Blocker: Atenolol 25 mg PO twice daily OR Metoprolol XL (Toprol XL) 25 mg daily	
Docusate sodium 100 mg twice daily PRN.	
Meds at home to continue.	
Anticoagulation: Weight Based Heparin Protocol bolus with _____ PTT at _____ OR Enoxaparin (Lovenox) _____ mg Subcutaneous q 12 hours	
IIb/IIIA Inhibitor: Eptifibatide (Integrillin) _____ at _____ mL/hr
