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| Summary | <p>The <i>Emergency Department & Triage Programs</i> target the most frequent and severe patient safety events that stem from a missed or delay in diagnosis. These online courses strike a chord with practicing clinicians and bring a front-of-mind awareness to those clinical risks that have historically plagued this high-risk specialty. The Triage Program emphasizes the importance of critical thinking skills at triage and reminds nurses of the key 'red flags'. Organizations that have a strong triage process can expect to see improvements in throughput, patient satisfaction, and quality measures related to the ED.</p> |
