
## EMRI Emergency Medicine Risk Initiative

evidenced by a reduction in cases of 'failure to diagnose', a reduction in medical errors and a reduction in malpractice cases of up to 40% in large hospital systems and medical groups.

The EMRI Risk and Safety Cycle consists of three components:
